

Tea Leaves From Harvest to Cup

HARVESTING

Harvesting can be done by HANDS or by MACHINERY, although hand-picked tea has smoother flavor and higher quality than the tea trimmed by machine. The top two or three leaves are the youngest and will give the best quality green tea.

PROCESSING

WITHERING

When the leaves are plucked they begin to wilt. Controlling the HUMIDITY, AIR FLOW, and TEMPERATURE during this process will prepare the leaves for further processing. The aim of this stage is reducing the moisture from leaves and allowing tea to develop its distinctive aroma and flavor.

STEAMING OR PAN-FRYING

Steaming or frying the tea leaves in the pan will save the green color of the leaves and STOP THEIR OXIDATION. This will prevent green tea leaves from becoming black or colong tea.

ROLLING

In this stage leaves are cooled, then rolled in order to break the leaf cells and release essential oils and enzymes which give tea its UNIQUE FLAVOR. Rolling can be done by hand or by machine.


DRYING

There are several types of drying but all of them have the same goals: to PRESERVE TEA for later usage, reduce any left moisture, and maintain the color and taste of the green tea.



SORTING

Sorting according to size and grade after drying, tea is being sorted according to SIZE AND GRADE and prepared for packaging. The highest quality tea is made from unbroken whole tea leaves.
